

DAY FIFTY

Read Ephesians 5:25-27 (ESV)

Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish

DAY FIFTY-ONE

Read Ephesians 5:28-30 (ESV)

In the same way husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself. For no one ever hated his own flesh, but nourishes and cherishes it, just as Christ does the church, because we are members of his body

DAY FIFTY-TWO

Read Proverbs 6:16-19 (ESV)

There are six things that the LORD hates, seven that are an abomination to him: haughty eyes, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood, a heart that devises wicked plans, feet that make haste to run to evil, a false witness who breathes out lies, and one who sows discord among brothers

DAY FIFTY-THREE

Read Colossians 3:12-13 (CEV)

God loves you and has chosen you as his own special people. So be gentle, kind, humble, meek, and patient. Put up with each other, and forgive anyone who does you wrong, just as Christ has forgiven you.

DAY FIFTY-FOUR

Read Song of Solomon 2:16-17 (CEV)

My darling, I am yours, and you are mine, as you feed your sheep among the lilies. Pretend to be a young deer dancing on mountain slopes until daylight comes and shadows fade away.

DAY FIFTY-FIVE

Read Romans 13:8-10 (CEV)

Let love be your only debt! If you love others, you have done all that the Law demands. In the Law there are many commands, such as, “Be faithful in marriage. Do not murder. Do not steal. Do not want what belongs to others.” But all of these are summed up in the command that says, “Love others as much as you love yourself.” No one who loves others will harm them. So love is all that the Law demands.

DAY FIFTY-SIX

Read Romans 13:13-14 (CEV)

So behave properly, as people do in the day. Don't go to wild parties or get drunk or be vulgar or indecent. Don't quarrel or be jealous. Let the Lord Jesus Christ be as near to you as the clothes you wear. Then you won't try to satisfy your selfish desires.

DAY FIFTY-SEVEN

Read John 15:12-13 (NLT)

This is my commandment: Love each other in the same way I have loved you. There is no greater love than to lay down one's life for one's friends.

DAY FIFTY-EIGHT

Read 1 John 4:7-8 (NLT)

Dear friends, let us continue to love one another, for love comes from God. Anyone who loves is a child of God and knows God. But anyone who does not love does not know God, for God is love.

DAY FIFTY-NINE

Read Colossians 3:14 (CEV)

Love is more important than anything else. It is what ties everything completely together.
