### **Read Romans 15:5-6 (CEV)**

## **DAY SIXTY-FOUR**

### **Read 1 John 4:21 (CEV)**

The commandment that God has given us is: "Love God and love each other!"

## **DAY SIXTY-FIVE**

### **Read 1 John 4:12 (CEV)**

No one has ever seen God. But if we love each other, God lives in us, and his love is truly in our hearts.

## **DAY SIXTY-SIX**

**Read Matthew 22: 36-39 (CEV)**

“Teacher, what is the most important commandment in the Law?” Jesus answered: Love the Lord your God with all your heart, soul, and mind. This is the first and most important commandment. The second most important commandment is like this one. And it is, “Love others as much as you love yourself.”

## **DAY SIXTY-SEVEN**

**Read Proverbs 10:12 (ESV)**

Hatred stirs up strife, but love covers all offenses.

## **DAY SIXTY-EIGHT**

**Read Luke 6:35-36 (CEV)**

But love your enemies and be good to them. Lend without expecting to be paid back. Then you will get a great reward, and you will be the true children of God in heaven. He is good even to people who are unthankful and cruel. Have pity on others, just as your Father has pity on you.

## **DAY SIXTY-NINE**

**Read Romans 12:6-8 (CEV)**

God has also given each of us different gifts to use. If we can prophesy, we should do it according to the amount of faith we have. If we can serve others, we should serve. If we can teach, we should teach. If we can encourage others, we should encourage them. If we can give, we should be generous. If we are leaders, we should do our best. If we are good to others, we should do it cheerfully.

## **DAY SEVENTY**

**Read 1 John 3:18-20 (CEV)**

Children, you show love for others by truly helping them, and not merely by talking about it. When we love others, we know we belong to the truth, and we feel at ease in the presence of God. But even if we don't feel at ease, God is greater than our feelings, and he knows everything.
